The purposes of the Futurity are to encourage the breeding of the best possible Schipperkes and to reward the breeders for their efforts. For these reasons, the Futurity Stake prizes are divided between the breeder and the owner, with recognition also given to the contribution of the sire. MATURITY CHALLENGE CLASS

The addition of the Maturity Challenge as a regular event at our National was unanimously approved by the SCA Board of Directors at the 2010 National in Colorado Springs and was introduced at the 2011 National Specialty Show.

The Maturity is designed to be educational and a complement to the Futurity. By bringing back the previous Futurity nominees and showcasing them as adults, breeders will have the opportunity to see not only how individual dogs have developed, but also how particular bloodlines grow and mature. The ages of the dogs will range from two years up to eight years of age. Maturity Dogs need not be entered in the regular classes. GROOMING & ELECTRICITY

“Premier” Reserved grooming will be located closest to the ring. These reserved 10’x10’ spaces are available for a one-time donation of \$25.00 for the entire week and are on a first come, first pay basis. This is a fundraiser. There is no charge for spaces that are not marked as reserved and are also on a first come, first served basis. There is no charge for electricity.

Please note that there is to be no grooming or bathing of dogs in the rooms per SCA's contract with the Hotel. The grooming setup will be available the evening of Sunday, April 16th. Reserved spaces will be clearly marked.

SHOW SITE INFORMATION

Ballroom Hours: Monday – Friday - open 6:30 am to 10:00 pm or until last SCA event is complete.

All dogs must be removed from the ballroom immediately after completion of SCA events each day.

If you plan to leave dogs unattended in your setup during show hours, a phone number that you can be reached at must be visibly posted in your setup in case of emergency.

No dogs are to remain in the grooming area overnight.

HOTEL RULES & CONDITIONS FOR DOG SHOWS

****A non-refundable Dog fee of \$50.00 applies****

1. The dog(s) must pose no threat to guests or hotel associates.
2. Dog(s) must be on a leash at all times when in public areas, hallways or the outside grounds of the hotel.
3. Dogs are not permitted in dining areas, swimming pool areas, fitness and business centers.
4. Dogs must be crated in guestrooms at all times when owners are not present. Plastic or protective sheets are required under all crates. Owner must be present while any member of the hotel staff is servicing the guestroom (housekeeping, engineering, etc) when a dog is in the room. Dogs must be restrained or removed from guestroom while hotel staff is present working in room. Hotel staff will not enter any room that has an unrestrained dog.
5. Daily housekeeping will be suspended if dogs are discovered left unattended in a guestroom.
6. All dogs must be registered at the front desk as they are allowed in designated rooms only. This is for servicing your room and for the safety of our team members.
7. No more than five dogs are permitted in any guestroom.
8. Dogs must be in good health and up to date on all relevant vaccinations (including rabies), house-trained, clean and free of any parasites such as ticks or fleas.
9. Any damage caused by dog(s) must be reported to management immediately so proper action can be taken to avoid inconvenience to other guests. The owner is liable for any damage or injury caused by dog(s).
10. The owner of the dog(s) is liable for the health, safety, and welfare of dogs staying on property.
11. Noise/Disruptive Complaints – barking and noise that is disruptive to other guests in the hotel is not acceptable. Upon receipt of two (2) noise or disruptive complaints, the guest may be asked to make alternate arrangements for their dog.
12. In accordance with local laws, please ensure that you pick up after your dog at all times. All litter is to be disposed of properly by guests. Additionally, dogs must be walked only in an area designated by the hotel (please ask a front desk agent for instructions).

13. Please do not give your dog a bath in the bathtub. A designated area has been set aside specifically for SCA. Should a bathtub drain become clogged due to dog hair, a \$300 fee will be assessed.

PARADES

Parade of Titleholders

Any Schipperke with an AKC title may be entered in the Parade of Titleholders. The entry blank must indicate – "Parade of Titleholders".

Parade of Veterans

Any Schipperke that is 7 years or older, regardless of titles, may be entered in the Parade of Veterans. The entry blank must indicate – "Parade of Veterans".

Parade of Rescues

Any Schipperke that was rescued from any rescue organization or shelter may be entered. The entry blank must indicate – "Parade of Rescues".

Each Parade entrant will receive a special memento with the dog's name imprinted. A description of the dog and its background will be read while the dog is presented. A brief owner-provided biography (100 words or less) on a separate sheet of paper must be sent to Superintendent with the entry.
